PDNS takes cyber attacks down at scale.

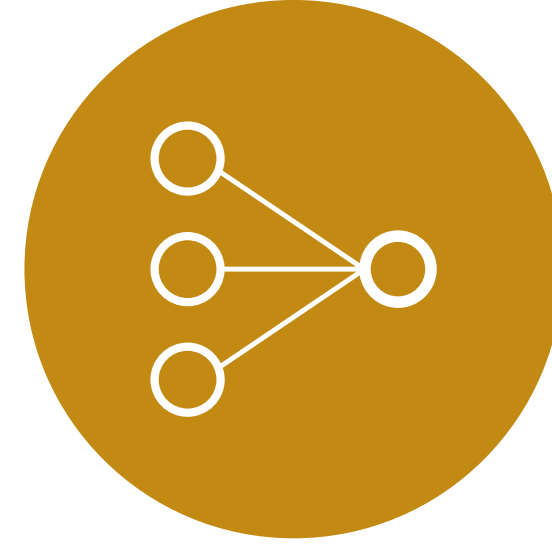
